The training is multi agency across the Children Leeds workforce.

This will include Youth Workers, School Nurses, Education Staff, L A Nurses, Voluntary Sector and Third Sector staff, NHS, FE & Children’s Services Staff.

Aim of the training:

To give professionals the knowledge, tools and skills to encourage young people to start thinking about their smoking habit and enable professionals to raise awareness about smoking, the health risks, myths, social and the environmental impacts of smoking.

Enable workers to raise the issue of smoking with young people, explore attitudes & values. Introduce best practice guidelines for smoking cessation work and making appropriate referrals to the local NHS Stop Smoking Service.
