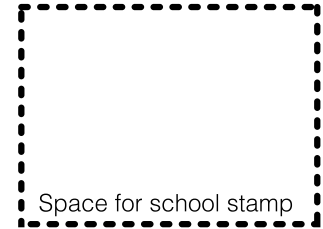

A school ID is required to receive items.

These are for use in the event of a pupil with diagnosed asthma or previously prescribed a salbutamol inhaler requiring it when their own is not available. This inhaler is being ordered (and will be used) in line with Human Medicines (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations 2014. It may be necessary to supply different spacers to cover the range of ages at the school.

Information for supplying pharmacist:

- Schools are now allowed to purchase salbutamol inhalers without a prescription for use in emergencies in their school. If you're unfamiliar with this chance to regulations please download the Department of Health Guidance from <https://www.gov.uk/>.
- Pharmacies are not required to provide inhalers or spacers free of charge, schools must pay for them
- Pharmacies should retain the signed order form for two years and make an entry in their POM register for audit purposes
