Send them packing!

What to do if you think your child has head lice:



- Stick any LIVE LICE found to a piece of white paper using clear sellotape and present it at your local pharmacy. A separate piece of paper will be needed for each child.
- 2. Your pharmacist will advise you what to do, and if appropriate, will issue Hedrin solution (free to those who are exempt from prescription charges).
- 3. Make sure to use Hedrin exactly as per the instruction leaflet provided when treating your child's hair.
- Check hair daily using a nit comb and conditioner - remove dead egg cases and any lice which may have survived.
- 5. Re-apply treatment every 7 days until all the head lice are gone.
- 6. Even after the head lice are gone, continue to check your child's hair at least once a week throughout their school-age years.
- 7. If you find any live lice repeat steps 1-6 above.
