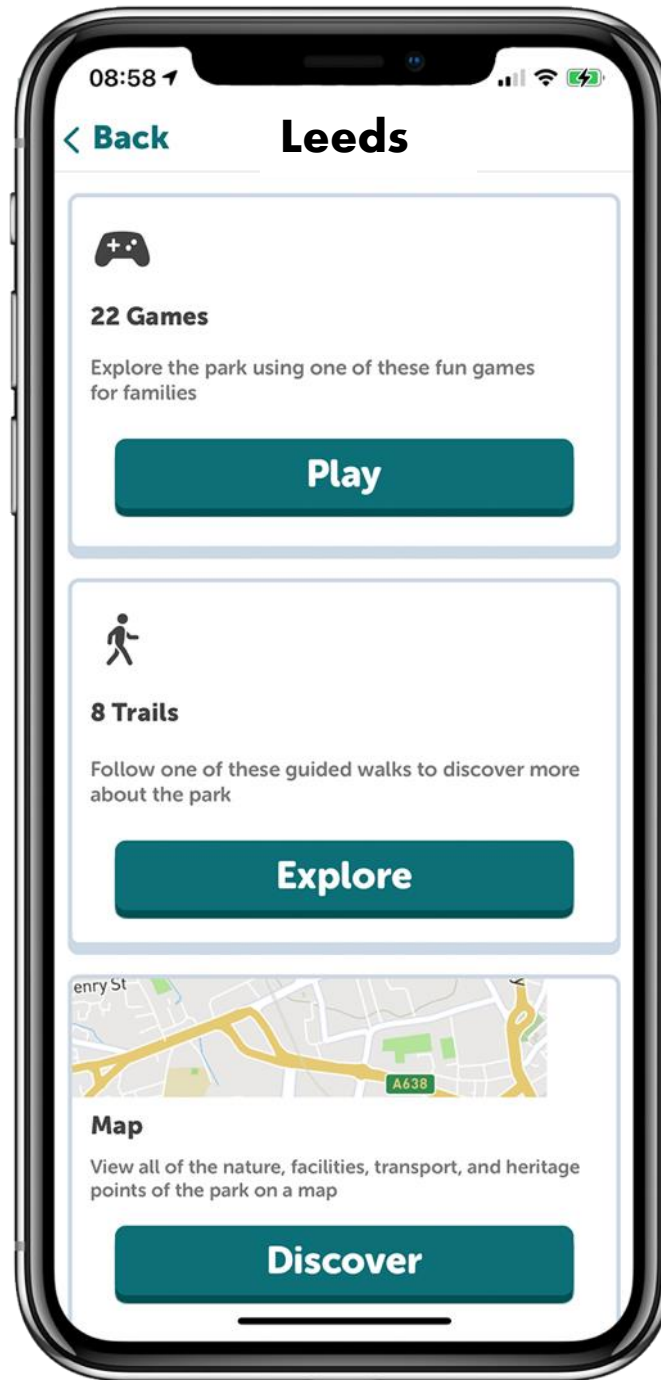

These follow a treasure hunt or quiz format. They use animated characters that you can find with your mobile phone to enhance a walk. Leeds already has a Dinosaur Safari, and there's a new offer every school holiday.



Trails

The trails give you a clear route to follow and tell you about the things that you are walking past. There is lots of variety from city centre routes to woodland strolls.



Map

The detailed map has a lot of information to help people find out more about the city. More content is being added to this all the time.

Almost **7,000** people have downloaded the app in Leeds since its launch in 2021. In a survey, **100%** of users recommended the app.

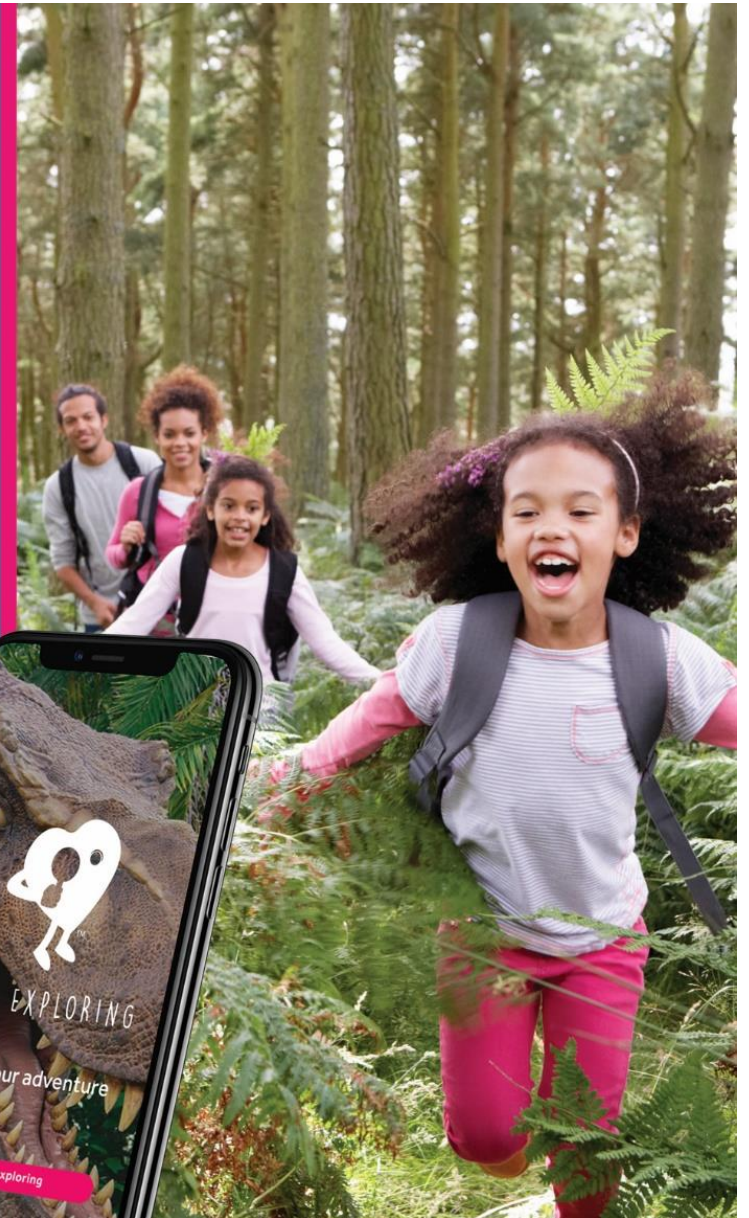

DID YOU PLAY THE DINOSAUR SAFARI YET?

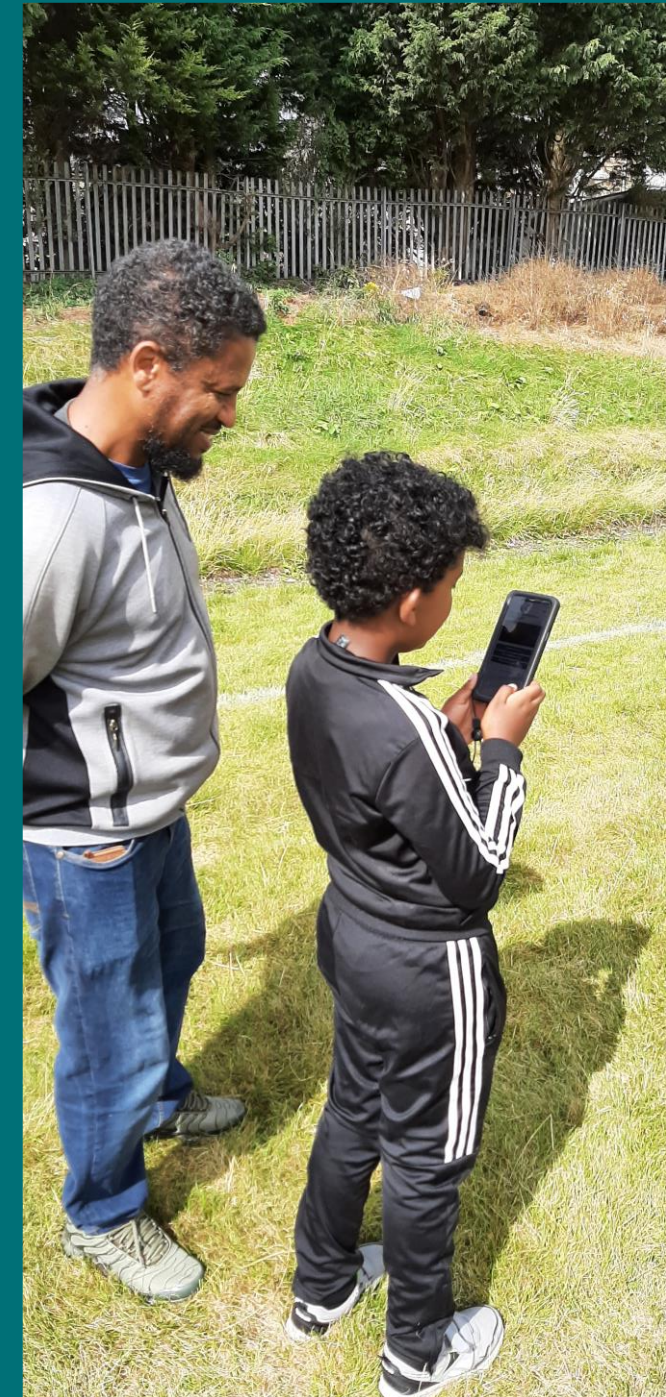
. You can play in lots of parks in Leeds. 72 thousand people played across the UK and they walked 505,303km looking for dinosaurs.

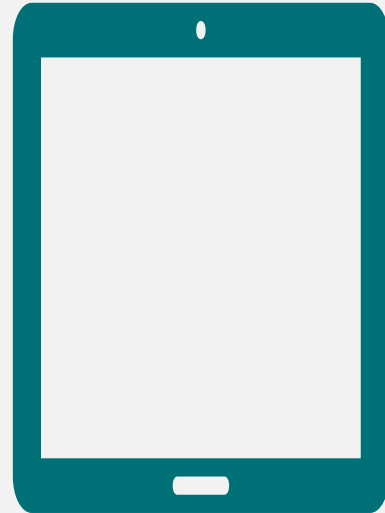



This Spring, Love Exploring Leeds launches its first citywide Inter-School Challenge

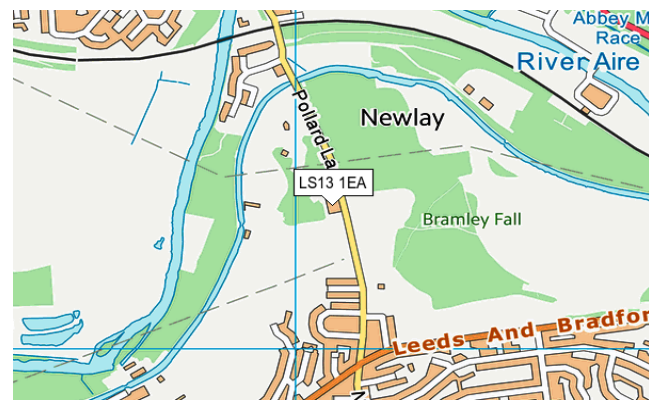
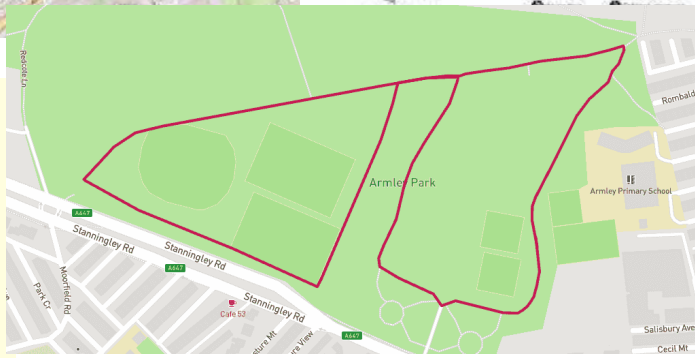
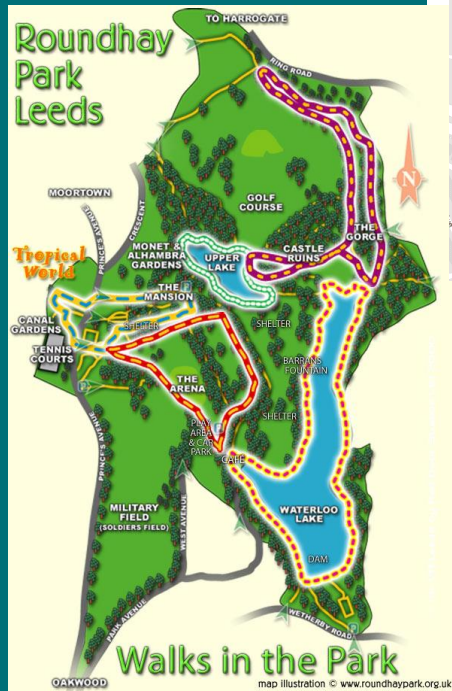

Join in with the city's biggest-ever bug hunt and win prizes for your school – and yourself ...

Schools from across the city are taking up the challenge to complete Love Exploring games in their local park – with loads of prizes up for grabs.

The Love Exploring app uses the magic of augmented reality to bring to life amazing sights on a smartphone – including a Dinosaur Safari, as well as the brand-new Mega Mini-Beast game.

You'll see huge butterflies, giant caterpillars or a roaring T-Rex as you play the Love Exploring games - getting active with your family and learning loads with an interactive quiz.

Ask your grown-up to download the app. Then enter the name of your school and choose a game near you. For every 100m you walk, and every quiz question you get right, you'll score points for your school. Keep track of how your school is doing on the live leader board.

Every school taking part wins a small prize - bonus prizes available too. The top scoring child will win an iPad.




THE INTER-SCHOOL CHALLENGE

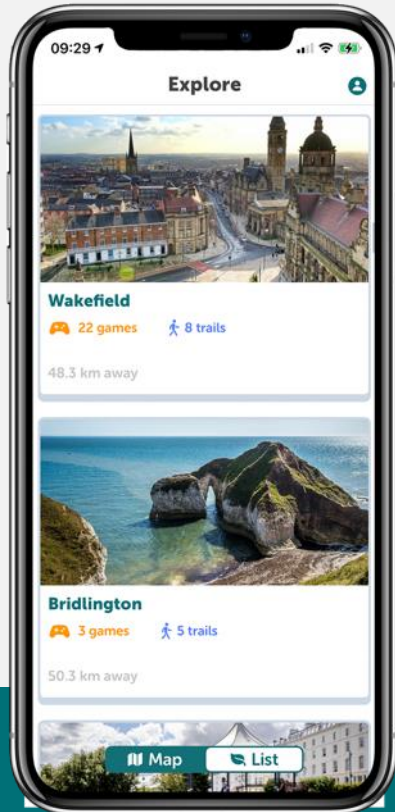

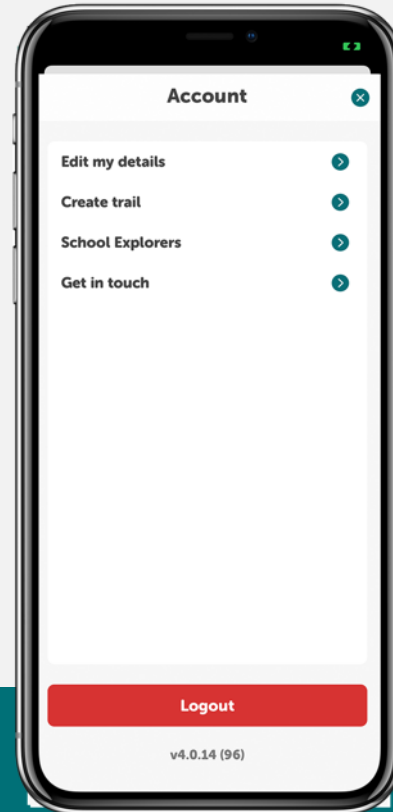

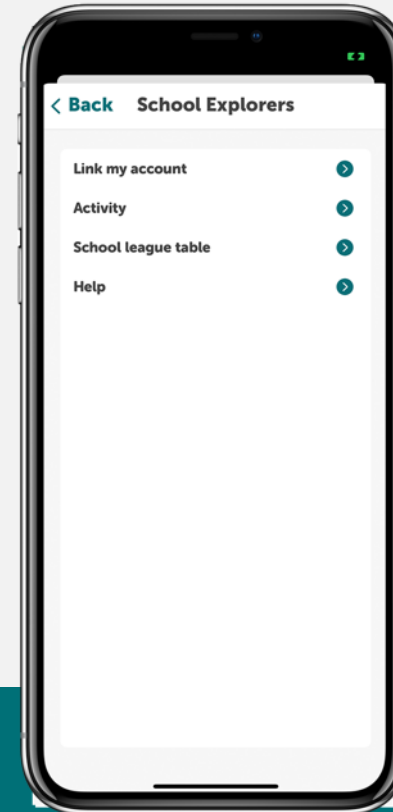
Just download the app and follow the menu choices below. When you have linked your account your points will be linked to your selected school.



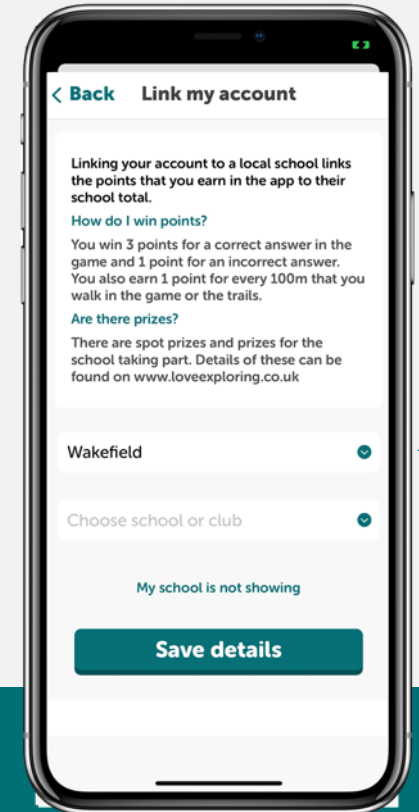

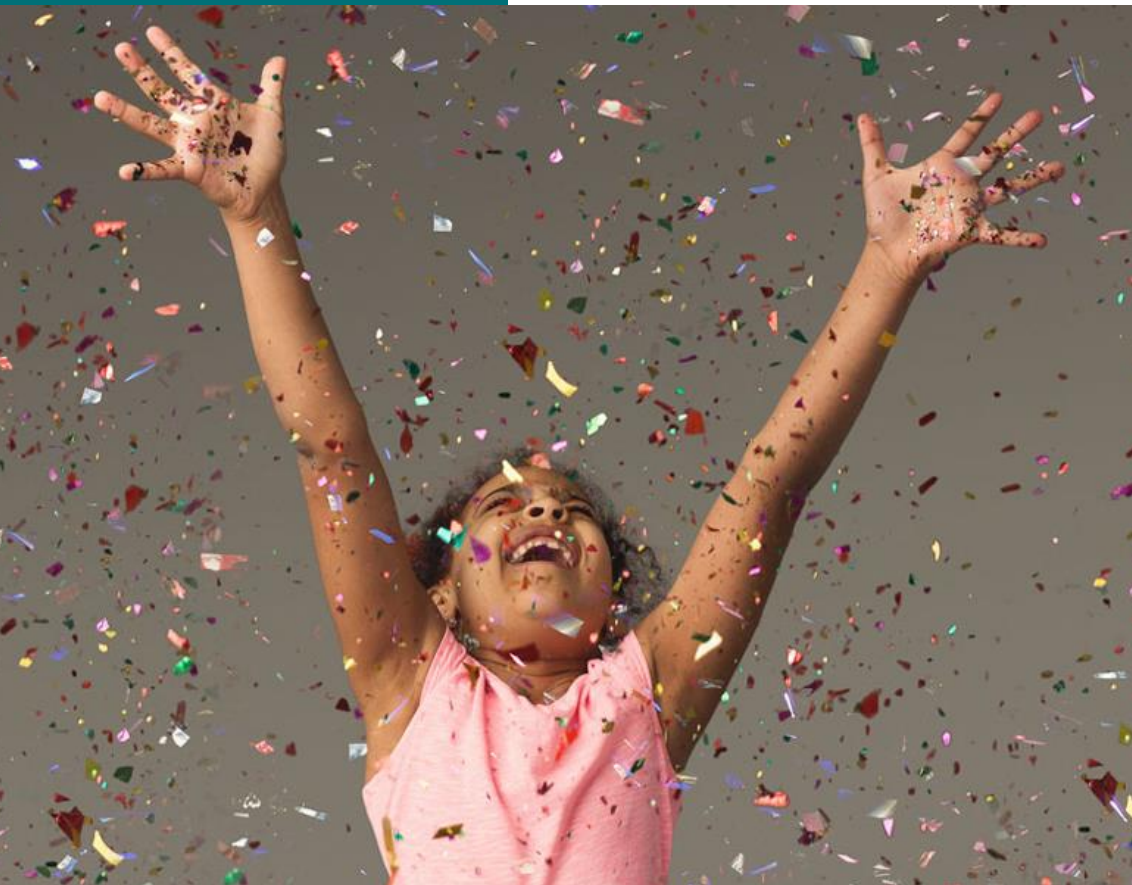

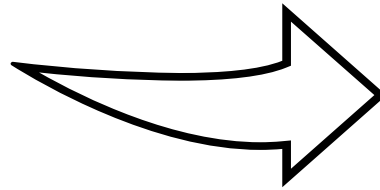
